THE CONCEPT :

The ANGLE KOMMODE is a very functional piece of furniture, as it gives you the possibility to create your own piece. It can be just a night stand beside you bed or an ordinary kommode with as many shelves as you want. It can also be an ANGLE KOMMODE fitting perfectly in every corner of your home. The ANGLE KOMMODE is made from high quality Croatian oak with FSC certificate, with no metal parts or any harmful components. The finishing is in natural high quality oil and wax. it can be offered also in a white pigment oil, or wenge oil.

LAKO is a system of stools is designed by Ms. Ada Kezić. It is a system of stools, benches and shelves of solid wood. It consists of square frames, transverse elements and panels joined together with a modified classical dovetailing joint and without any metal fastening. The shelves can be built up in modular manner both height and weight. Easy to assemble, it is made of solid wood-Croatian oak, beech or ash, surface-treated with mixture of organic oils and waxes.

Under the ECOMOVEL program, FCBA piloted and advised four companies and designers of south of France to design their product eco-design all made in France.



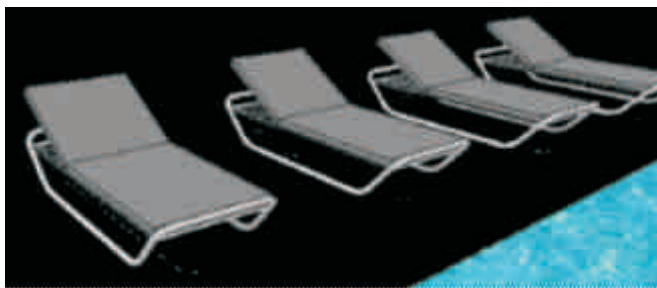

The aria system is featured by:

- » very fast and easy assembly
- » integrated appearance
- » optimization for the transportation
- » easier customization
- » easy to be disassembled and to be rebuilt in different spaces with different needs
- » 43% decrease of transportation volume for the basic module, -57% for the double module.
- » raw material reduction, easier production: the system is composed by a framework with vertical partitions.

FIRST PILOT PROJECT: DRESSING AREA

In this collaborative project, Navarro Azorín which is a producer of furniture fittings and Tinto which is a furniture manufacturer, designed this Eco dressing area with the following features:

- The wood used is ash with a natural wax finish
- The pulls of the drawers are made of wood plastic composite avoiding the employment of additional coatings
- The metallic bars are made of recycled steel
- The dressing area is an open space without doors avoiding therefore, the overuse of materials.

SECOND PILOT PROJECT: DESK AND CHAIR
